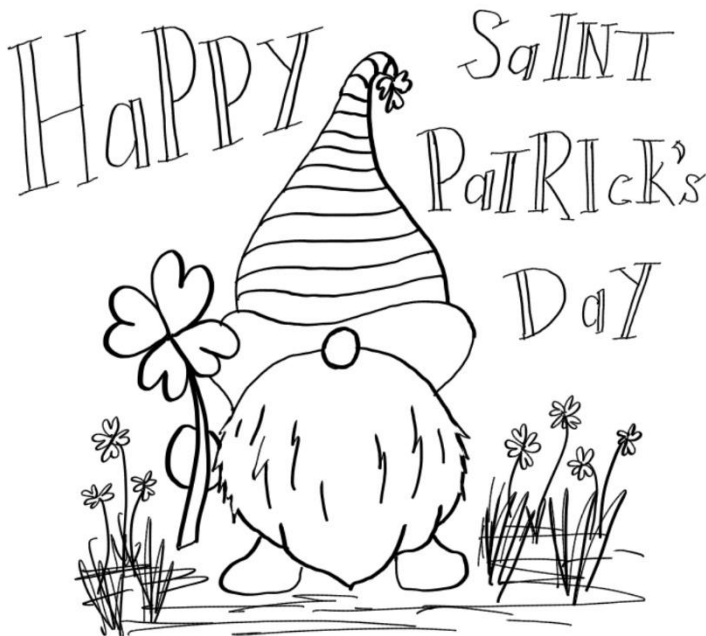
- At 10:30 AM, the Bethel Township Sewer Authority is one of the first to arrive at the party.
